Foundational Community Supports (FCS) is also referred to as Initiative 3 of the Healthier Washington Medicaid Transformation. FCS helps our most vulnerable beneficiaries get and keep stable housing and employment, in support of their broader health needs. This program provides housing and employment case management to Medicaid patients with a history of mental illness or substance use disorder.
